A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF OBSOLETE ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT (E-WASTE) FOLLOWING THE UPGRADE OF COMPUTER HARD DRIVES, MONITORS, AND PRINTERS

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of North Central Solid Waste Authority (NCSWA) met in regular session; and

WHEREAS, the NCSWA has recently completed an upgrade of its computer systems to improve operational efficiency, cybersecurity, and service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the upgrade has rendered certain electronic equipment—including desktop computers, laptops, monitors, and related peripherals—obsolete, surplus, or no longer suitable for official use; and

WHEREAS, the proper disposal of electronic waste (e-waste) is necessary to ensure compliance with applicable environmental regulations and to prevent potential harm to public health and the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

1. Declaration of Surplus Property
The electronic equipment identified herein is obsolete or no longer required for operational purposes is hereby declared surplus property.
2. Authorization of Disposal
NCSWA is authorized to dispose of surplus property.
3. Environmentally Responsible Handling
All e-waste shall be disposed of through certified recycling vendors, donation programs, or other environmentally responsible methods that comply with federal, state, and local regulations.
4. Data Security Measures
Prior to disposal, all data-bearing devices shall undergo secure data destruction procedures to ensure that no sensitive or confidential information is recoverable.
5. Effective Date
This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
