

**NORTH CENTRAL SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY  
RESOLUTION 2018-013  
RESIDENTIAL ROUTES FOR HANDICAPS**

**WHEREAS**, North Central Solid Waste Authority provides residential solid waste collection for the unincorporated portions of Rio Arriba County; and

**WHEREAS**, in order for a customer to qualify to be on a handicap route the customer must provide proof each year of handicap status; and

**WHEREAS**, the customer must provide proof each person living in dwelling a handicap placard; and

**WHEREAS**, the customer must also provide for each person living in dwelling a letter from their primary care provider that they cannot pull polycart to area permitted by the Authority; and


**WHEREAS**, the Authority shall apply a handicap stencil to the polycart to verify that the customer is on the handicap route; and

**WHEREAS**, the customer will sign a notarized document giving NCSWA permission to enter their yards and not to hold NCSWA liable for any damages caused to customer's dwellings or property during the normal course of providing solid waste collection services at customer's property.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE NORTH CENTRAL SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY SHALL:**

1. Request a handicap placard from each customer living in the home.
2. Request a formal letter from each customer's doctor stating that they cannot take polycart to area permitted by NCSWA.
3. NCSWA will not be held liable for any damages caused to customer's dwellings that are on handicap routes.
